Components of a "Simple" Estate Plan

(Involves no specialized planning for federal estate tax or Indiana inheritance tax) (Example plan for a married couple with minor children)

Wills for both spouses

- · Includes testamentary trusts for benefit of children and/or other beneficiaries
- · Includes guardianship provisions (if needed)
- · Can include "special needs trusts" to protect needs-based benefits for disabled children or other beneficiaries

Advance Directives for both spouses

- · General Durable Power of Attorney (financial)
- · Health Care Durable Power of Attorney
- · Appointment of Health Care Representative
- · Living Wills (if desired)
- · Funeral Planning Declarations (if desired)

Analysis of Non-Probate Assets

- Titling and Legal Effect of Jointly-Owned Property
- Titling and Legal Effect of Transfer-On-Death Accounts
- Beneficiary Designated Assets and Change of Beneficiary Forms
 - · Life Insurance
 - · Retirement Accounts (401(k)s, IRAs, 403(b)s, pension plans, etc)
